



-NOTICE OF SPEED HUMP PROPOSAL-

TO: Homeowners of the Pebble Creek Farm subdivision

RE: Speed Humps Proposed for **Cobble Creek Lane & Pebble Bend Drive**

The Gwinnett County Department of Transportation has a program that allows property owners to petition for speed humps to be installed on public, residential streets. This notice is to inform you that a petition for speed humps has been approved for a street in your neighborhood.

A speed study was conducted on the street in question and determined that Speed Hump installation will be recommended if approval from **70%** of the properties in the petition area for Cobble Creek Lane (shown in yellow) & **90%** of the properties in the petition area for Pebble Bend Drive (shown in lighter yellow) is obtained. The number of humps and placement of the humps is represented on the attached map. Homeowners with property (shown in yellow) that abuts the street with speed humps will be eligible to sign the petition. It will be circulated by a neighborhood representative.

When the petition is submitted and meets all requirements, GCDOT will recommend that the speed humps be installed as shown. If the speed humps are approved by the Board of Commissioners and installed, each property in the petition area (shown in yellow) will be assessed \$12.00 annually for future maintenance of the speed humps.
